Easy Leftover Turkey Casserole

Here's a great way to use up leftovers from your holiday meals. You can substitute chicken, ham or whatever you have on hand.

Ingredients

- 1 can condensed cream of mushroom soup
 - 1/2 cup milk (more if needed)
 - 1½ cups cooked pasta (any shape)
 - 1 cup frozen mixed veggies, thawed
 - 1½ cups cooked turkey, chopped
 - Ground black pepper (to taste)
 - 1 tube of crescent roll dough

Preheat oven to 375°. Combine the first 5 ingredients in a saucepan over medium heat. Stir to combine until heated through. Season with pepper. Transfer to a greased 8-inch square baking dish (or similar sized casserole dish). Unroll the crescent dough and arrange it over top of the mixture. Poke some holes to allow steam to escape. Bake approx. 15 min., or until crust is golden. For extra yum, sprinkle some shredded cheese on top a few minutes before baking is complete.
