
Spring Pea Pesto

- 1 1/2 cups green peas (fresh or frozen)
- salt & pepper to taste
- Zest and juice of ½ lemon
- 2 tbsp olive oil
- 2 sprigs fresh herbs: mint, tarragon, dill, or your favourite
- 1/3 cup nuts: pine nuts, almonds, or other (optional)

This recipe is easy and *flexible*. All ingredients can be adjusted to taste, and you can mix and match the herbs and nuts as much as you like. Combine all ingredients except the oil in a food processor or blender. Pulse a few times to get everything chopped, then slowly add the oil and blend until well blended and smooth. Serve as a pasta sauce or dip, or spread it on toast. It also freezes well.
