- **Waste Collection:** Did you know that you can check when your garbage and recycling schedule is online?

- **Application to Alters** – Please note that we will accept application to alters, but we will not be reviewing them until further notice. If you have any questions, please contact us.
- **Yard Waste Acceptable Items:** Leaves, grass, garden waste, straw, cornstalks must be in paper leaf bags. Please do not push your leaves to the road as they clog our basins. Thank you
