- Bulky item pickup will resume on May 21st. Due to office closure, you are required to email or phone us by noon Wed. May 20th with a maximum of 3 items that you would like to be picked up. There will not be stickers issued. My team will pick up what is on our list.
- Spring cleaning has begun and grass cutting will eventually follow. Please be patient and know that the ground is wet in many areas that we cannot cut. We are also hiring our seasonal team and there are current challenges with this also. We will do the best that we can for you.
