Re: Notice of Construction Re-start  
Lockhart Road Reconstruction and Servicing Project

Dear Resident,

We wish to advise you that commencing the week of October 18, 2021, weather dependent, the reconstruction and servicing of Lockhart Road from the 20<sup>th</sup> Sideroad to the 25<sup>th</sup> Sideroad will resume. The General Contractor will complete the reconstruction of the roadway between the Parkbridge Operations Yard and the power station including paving the 1<sup>st</sup> coat of asphalt on the roadway. They will also complete the associated works including, but not limited to, the removal and replacement of concrete curbs and gutters, complete the restoration of ditches and slopes, shouldering and line painting.

This work is anticipated to be completed at the end of November 2021, weather dependent.

The Contractor will return in the spring of 2022 to pave the 2<sup>nd</sup> coat of asphalt.

**Public Road Access & Traffic Disruptions**

- Traffic disruptions will occur during construction.
- One lane closures will be in place, as required, with traffic control in effect, between October 18 and November 30, 2021.
- Full closure of the roadway from the power station to Weeping Willow is planned to be in effect between October 25 to November 3, 2021, weather dependent.
- Full closure of the roadway from Weeping Willow to the Parkbridge Operations Yard is planned to be in effect between November 4-12, 2021, weather dependent.
- Detour routes will be set up ahead of time and digital signs have been installed notifying of the road closures.
- Driveway access will be maintained throughout the construction, except for temporary disturbances while working in front of driveways. For temporary driveway disturbances, the contractor will advise where to park.
- Please refrain from parking your car on the road during construction hours between 7:00am to 7:00pm.
