We have a lot going on in our community for construction this summer and we like to keep you informed about everything that is happening.

Road paving and speed bumps are done!

Line painting for our recreational center parking lots and speed bumps will start Wednesday night on Sept 1st. It will be a couple of days

before everything is completed. Certain sections will be blocked off for 20 -30mins to allow paint to dry. Alternative routes will be available.

Please avoid walking or driving on any freshly painted section so you don't turn a bright yellow. Additionally, we will be installing 5 brand new seasonal speed bumps in high speeding areas by Sept 8th. Please watch your speed at all times when driving in the community.

The city of Innisfil Conservation (in conjunction with Parkbridge Point Endeavour) is building a walking path and Turtle Sanctuary behind Cornerbrook Trail. The path will be adjacent to Sandycove Acres and will be available for everyone in the community to use. The path will also include a small walking bridge that will lead to a Conservation Area for Turtles.
