

All about the Veterans' Social Club...

SANDYCOVE VETERANS' CLUB HISTORY

The Sandycove Veterans Social Club started in 1979. Sadly, none of the original founders are still living in the community. Every year, the Sandycove Veterans have conducted a Remembrance Day Service which is attended by approximately two hundred people. Sea Cadets, Army Cadets, Air force Cadets, and Navy League Cadets based at The Barrie, Ontario Armoury all send contingents led by their respective officers. We utilize one from each of the Cadet Corps to lower and raise our Flags during the Last Post. Local Cubs and Scouts are also included.

The wreath-laying includes municipal, provincial and federal politicians along with a number of individuals wishing to remember past family and friends. In 1982 a group of Veterans started the planning necessary to erect a memorial in honour of those men and women who paid with their lives so that we could live ours

in freedom. A field gun, dating back to World War I, was obtained at an auction and mounted where you see it today in front of the Hub Recreation Hall. More recently, a new memorial has been erected and a dedication ceremony was conducted on Nov. 1, 2013. Every Canada Day, a group of veterans leads the parade here in Sandycove carrying our flags and colours.

Socially, the club holds a variety of functions most months throughout the year. This may be a dance, brunch, breakfast, dine-out or fun day where we visit a Legion Branch or to a Peacekeeper event in Angus.
