<u>QUALIFICATIONS TO BOOK</u> - if you get the message "there are no appointments available to book" in your area, it may be because you must be within the following timeframe to have it done at this onsite Go Vax bus on Nov 2nd : You can receive a <u>bivalent booster at least six months from your last</u> <u>dose</u>. If you are high risk for severe COVID-19 illness <u>recommended interval is three months</u> from your last dose. Pfizer bivalent vaccine and the Moderna bivalent vaccines are available. Both bivalent vaccines provide better protection against the most recently circulating COVID-19 variants in Ontario.

high risk of severe COVID-19 illness, include:

· Individuals aged 65 and over

• Residents of long-term care homes, retirement homes, Elder Care Lodges and individuals living in other congregate settings that provide assisted-living and health services

· First Nation, Inuit and Métis individuals and their non-Indigenous household members aged 18 and over

 \cdot Moderately to severely immunocompromised individuals aged 12 and over

· Health care workers aged 18 and over.
