Did you know that the County of Simcoe Paramedics offer a **"Community Paramedic Home Visit Program"?**

The program supports patients to stay healthy and independent in their own homes. The program offers integrated, in-home care by Community Paramedics. They receive additional training and specialize in CHR (Congestive Heart Failure), COPD (Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease) and Diabetes. They maintain a direct connection with the patient's primary care provider and can minimize the need for 9-1-1 calls and hospital visits.

Community Paramedics work in collaboration with local health service providers and act as an extension of primary care to support patients to manage their chronic health conditions. They provide comprehensive in-home health assessments, including checking vital signs and blood work, providing vaccinations, and helping patients understand how to manage their health conditions.

EMERGENCY RESPONDERS NEED YOUR HELP!



On a recent drive through parts of Sandycove Acres at night, I was very concerned to see how many problems exist for our EMS (ambulance), Fire and Police Departments when responding to 911 calls at night.

<u>Problem No. 1</u> Almost **15%** of the homes I saw DID NOT have the pole lights outside their homes/parking areas lit. Either the light bulb was burned out or the resident may have turned off the breaker to the light post.

<u>Solution</u>s: If your light is burned out, contact Parkbridge, who will replace the bulb or replace the light pole if needed – there is no charge to you for this.

If you feel the pole light is using too much hydro (under \$5.00/yr – less with LED lighting), think how you will feel if an ambulance can't find your home in the dark, someone gets hit by a car in front of your dark area or you get mugged getting in and out of a vehicle. Please don't turn off the power to the pole light. It is there for your safety and the safety of others. It also discourages criminal acts.



<u>Problem No. 2</u> Almost **50%** of the homes had house numbers that cannot be seen from the street, even with a very strong flashlight aimed directly where the numbers should be or might be. Some houses don't even have any numbers on them (this was verified during a daytime tour of the same area).

Solutions

- Your numbers should be a minimum of 6" high;
- Your numbers must be a colour contrasting to the colour of the surface where you put them; (put black on light colours, white on dark colours). Some brass/gold/chrome/silver numbers do not show up well on any surface.
- Your numbers must be placed in an area where they can be seen easily from the street, from either direction, day or night;
- If your house is on a corner and the 'side' of your home is 'your address', put a number on the side and think about putting another sign at the 'front' showing the full address – for example – if your address is 55 Dingdong Street but you actually face Clarabelle Court – put '55' on the side facing Dingdong Street and '55' or '55 Dingdong' on the front/side facing Clarabelle Court. This is very important for EMS.
- Your numbers should not be stickers placed on the front of a light globe; in the dark the numbers are not visible, they only show as dark patches;
- Front door and side door lights should be functioning with bright lightbulbs for your safety as well as visitors and First Responders;
- Bushes, plants and trees should be cut back or removed so as to not interfere with the visibility of your house number and lights.
