As noted, if you cannot attend the AGM for any reason, you can still vote by using the proxy sheets in the Members' AGM Mailing, filling them in and sending them back as instructed. That way you still can vote!



Ann Burke, Able Bodied Seawoman, WREN, (1966-1970)

H.M.C.S Stadacona, Halifax, N.S. Royal Canadian Navy

Ann has lived in Sandycove since 2010 with her husband Gordon.

She had a love of the sea since early childhood. Ann was born in Birmingham, England and moved to the Isle of Wight at a young age where she lived on a yacht. Ann's family moved to Ontario so that her father could work on the AVRO Arrow. Ann however, never lost her love for the sea.

Ann joined the Navy at the tender age of 18 and never looked back. During her time in the Service, she was a Radar Plotter/Navigation Operator and a Wartime Tactics Operator (simulator). Ann was also trained at the Maritime Warfare School in nuclear, chemical and



biological defence, as well as firefighting. During the annual NATO exercises, Ann worked on Aircraft Sorties reporting.

The Canadian Legion Magazine will be publishing a light-hearted article she wrote on her lifelong love of the sea and the history of her beloved HMCS Bonaventure (watch for it). To top off all these accomplishments, Ann has been immortalized at the Canadian War Museum in Ottawa with photos of her modelling the Unified Services uniforms. A lot

of knowledge, education and experiences were crammed into her time in the Service.

This is a personal phone number. PLEASE only call during reasonable hours. If no one answers, leave a message with your name, address, phone number and the details of your appointment. I will get back to you. A driver will call you to confirm your appointment details and establish a pickup time for your appointment.

#### In the event of an Emergency, please call 911 as we do not provide this service.

**NOTE:** Sandycove Drug Store will deliver your prescription as well as OTC goods for a small fee. And you'll get to see our very own Pat Laidlaw when she comes to deliver.

#### Regular Rides: This fee goes to the driver to offset their gas.

#### Failure to notify a Driver of a cancelled appointment = \$10.00 Fee at Pick Up

Parking fees incurred are your extra charge. As an alternative...perhaps you could buy your driver a coffee at the nearest Tim Horton's and make arrangements to call him/her after your appointment. ©

Amounts are doubled on regular drives if they are over 2 hours. Questions about longer distances/longer appointments? Please discuss this ahead of time with the Coordinator so that there are no misunderstandings.
